Workshop Note

- Housekeeping Saw Cutting Room. Please leave the cutting saws in a clean condition after use. Clean
 oil off all surfaces using the plastic cards and wipe down with rags supplied.
- Saw cutting Room. Wooden Wedges should be use to hold your stone securely in the vice in the cutting Saw. Also a wooden plate would hold your stone more securely in the Vice.
- Leather Sole Shoes and Thongs should NOT BE WORN in the cutting room for your Personal Safety.
- We still need clean rags for the cleaning of the Saws. If you can assist with suppling rags, could you please cut them to a suitable size before giving to the Club?
